



## Napkin folding: Christmas tree

### Picture this: Holiday memorable moments

Brighten your holiday table with this napkin folding project. Looks great using any color or pattern fabric napkin. For best results, iron the napkin beforehand.

**Supplies:** Square cloth napkin – 20" x 20" (or at least 16" x 16")



#### Step 1

Fold napkin in half. Carefully line up the corners.



#### Step 2

Fold in half again. Carefully line up the corners.



#### Step 3

Rotate napkin so the four "outside" corners face you.



#### Step 4

Fold the corners up, one at a time.



#### Step 5

Stagger, as shown. Smooth napkin.



#### Step 6

"Sandwich" the napkin between your hands.



#### Step 7

Flip it over.



#### Step 8

One at a time, fold each outside corner over to the middle of the opposite side's edge. It should look a bit like a kite. Top edges of folded-over corners should now be parallel to you.





### Step 9

Gently “sandwich” the napkin between your hands again.



### Step 10

Flip it over. Rotate it so the small point is at the top.



### Step 11

Starting at the top, fold each flap up.



### Step 12

Tuck flaps 2 through 5 under the one above it, hiding the pointed corner.



### Step 13

All done! Feel free to add your own touches such as edible décor.
