# Spring Harvest Salad

21/2 tablespoons olive

1 tablespoon balsamic

1½ teaspoons Dijon

Dressing:

vinegar

mustard

lettuce 2½ cups spinach leaves 11/2 cups sliced strawberries 1 cup fresh blueberries 1/2 cup thinly sliced green 1. Combine leaf lettuce and spinach leaves with

blueberries and green

onion in a large salad

2. Prepare dressing by

lemon juice, olive oil,

**5 cups** torn spring leaf

balsamic vinegar, Dijon mustard, honey and salt; **pour** over lettuce mixture and toss to coat.

3. Sprinkle salad with feta cheese and sliced almonds.

4. Serve immediately.
