A quip from the Cultural Arts Committee

In the October newsletter, I discussed the principles of art. This month we're talking about the elements of art, which are the basic elements that are used by artists in creating art; they are what they use to create an aesthetically pleasing work. Many of these same things can be used in photography.

Line-A mark made by a pointed tool such as a brush, pen or stick; a moving point

Shape-A flat, enclosed area that has two dimensions, length and width. Artists use both geometric and organic shapes.

Color-One of the most important elements. It is created by light. There are three properties of color; hue (name), value (shades and tints), and intensity (brightness).

Value-Degrees of lightness or darkness. The difference between values is called value contrast

Form-Objects that are three-dimensional having length, width, and height. They can be viewed from many sides. Forms make up space and volume.

Texture-Describes the feel of an actual surface. The surface quality of an object; can be real or implied.







Whether you're a complete beginner or looking to brush up on your sewing techniques, these free sewing classes are perfect for all adults. Open to all skill levels.


