Forever Young Club: This club meets the third Wednesday of each month at the Muhlenberg County Extension Service. The ladies in this group are active in all programs in Muhlenberg County Homemakers as well as many churches, community clubs, programs and projects. The Forever Young Homemakers have servants hearts, they volunteer in various food and nutrition projects, like *Food Explorers* and the annual *BBQ & Bean Supper*; and enjoy the various educational opportunities offered through Cooperative Extension.
